Recent Projects

The following is a sample of some recent EUS projects:

- **RESL:** EUS was awarded the contract to build the 25kV collector system for the 22MW Point Tupper Wind Farm in Nova Scotia. Project began in January 2010.
- **City of Summerside:** EUS was awarded the design/construct contract for a 7km 34.5kV Hendrix line from a 12MW wind farm in PEI to the Summerside substation. The project ran from June 2009 to November 2009.
- **Eastlink:** EUS was awarded the contract to construct 43 wireless structures (composite poles) in Nova Scotia. The project ran from April 2009 to October 2009.
- **GDF Suez:** EUS was awarded the contract to construct the 34.5kV collector system and substation for the 99MW Caribou Mountain Wind Farm in New Brunswick. The project ran from April 2009 to October 2009.
- **Seaside Communications:** EUS was awarded the contract to construct 120 composite and wooden wireless structures in Nova Scotia. The project ran from April 2009 to September 2009.
- **RMSenergy:** EUS was awarded the EPC contract for the 34.5kV electrical system for the 51MW Dalhousie Mountain Wind Farm in Nova Scotia. The project ran from January 2009 to January 2010.
- **Maritime Electric:** EUS constructed a 60km 138kV transmission line from GDF Suez's 100MW West Cape Wind Farm in PEI to the Summerside substation. The project ran from October 2008 to February 2009.
- **TransAlta:** EUS constructed the 34.5kV collector system for the 96MW Kent Hills Wind Farm in New Brunswick. The project ran from July 2008 to November 2008.
- **Nova Scotia Power:** EUS was awarded the transmission and distribution maintenance and construction contracts for the Province of Nova Scotia. The contract runs from 2008-2011.
- **New Brunswick Power:** EUS was awarded the transmission maintenance and construction contract for the Province of New Brunswick. The contract runs from 2010-2012 (initial contract was from 2007-2009).
